



Trials begin at cancer centre

A PIONEERING unit solely devoted to cancer prevention and screening has started operating in the UK.

Several clinical trials have already begun at the new **Cancer Research UK** facility, part of **Queen Mary, University of London**.

A spokesperson for the charity said: "The development of a trials unit, whose single focus is cancer prevention and screening, will help increase the pace of research. Previous experience in setting up and running trials will enable faster start-ups, recruitment of patients and reporting of results."

Queen Mary is a large multi-faculty college spread around a number of different sites in east London.
